



“Dream Week” dining to benefit AIDS Resource Center Ohio

June 1-6, 2009

Twenty-six local independent restaurants will create special menus and taste delights in support of the AIDS Resource Center (ARC) Ohio during “Dream Week,” June 1-6, 2009. In its inaugural year, this weeklong dining event is the counterpart to the annual RED Design and Dine Gala, also sponsored by ARC Ohio. One dollar from each Dream Meal purchased at a participating restaurant during the week will benefit ARC Ohio. The Pine will donate a percentage of all purchases made during the week. “Dream Week is an exciting event that will tantalize diners with new taste sensations from their tried and true favorites,” said Jack Omer, ARC Ohio special events director, “It’s also the



perfect week for diners to try out restaurants they’ve never experienced while helping those infected, affected and at risk of HIV/AIDS in the Miami Valley at the same time.”

Dream Week will kick off with a special “Sip and Sample,

Eat and Greet” event on Sunday, May 31, from 4-7pm at the Taj Ma Garaj, 300 Perry Street, Dayton. Tickets are \$50 and include unlimited beer, wine and food provided by all of the participating restaurants. In addition, ARC Ohio has produced a never-before-released cookbook featuring the independent restaurants showcased during Dream Week. Cookbooks are \$25 and will be available at the Dream Week Kickoff event, as well as at select restaurant locations and at the ARC Ohio offices.

Celebrating its 25th anniversary, AIDS Resource Center Ohio is a nonprofit, community-based organization that provides services to those infected, affected and

at risk of HIV/AIDS.

Proceeds raised from Dream Week will help ARC Ohio provide comprehensive support services, HIV testing and counseling, prevention education, linkage to care, and advocacy will be provided for more than 15,000 Ohioans this year. For more information visit www.arcoho.org.
