With the Oakwood School District facing budget cuts for the 2009-2010 school year, the Academic Decathlon program was at risk of being eliminated. Academic Decathlon is a year-long interdisciplinary course that focuses on one topic and culminates in a competition that tests students in 10 different areas. The team is uniquely composed of students from the "A", "B", and "C" GPA category levels. OHS has enjoyed an impressive record of achievements over the years. In April 2009, the OHS Academic Decathlon team, coached by English teacher, Mrs. Lori Morris, placed fourth in the nation at the

Unites States Academic Decathlon Medium School Online Nationals, a contest the team qualified for after placing first in the Medium/Small School Ohio Academic Decathlon State Competition in March 2009.

Many students on the OHS team received special recognition for individual high scores in select subject areas. Chris Mudry ('09) and Jeremiah Johnson ('11) earned the prestigious Golden Eagle award for earning the highest score in their individual categories. Each received a \$500 cash award for his accomplishment.
